



## TAPAZOLE (METHIMAZOLE)

You have been prescribed Tapazole (also called Methimazole) for your thyroid condition. This can **rarely** cause several side effects.

Rarely it can cause inflammation of the liver. Should you notice yellowing of your eyes or skin, stop your medication immediately and call the office.

It can also rarely cause a low white blood cell count. If you experience a sore throat, fever or any other infection, please stop the Tapazole and contact the office to have a lab order for a CBC level to be drawn immediately.

Sometimes patients can also be allergic to the medicine. If you develop a rash or joint pain after starting on the medication, please stop your medicine and contact our office.
